Research Interests

My research adopts an **evolutionary and socio-functional perspective** to understand how humans navigate disease threats, coordinate cooperation, and regulate intergroup relations.

Moral Emotions and Social Coordination. I investigate how emotions like anger and disgust function as **communicative signals** that shape punishment, cooperation, and conflict resolution. My work examines how these emotions predict behavioral responses, how their expression influences observers' actions, and how emotion-behavior mappings vary cross-culturally.

Behavioral Immune System and Social Trade-offs. I examine **pathogen avoidance mechanisms** and their effects on social behavior, studying when people relax disease-related avoidance for valued partners. This work integrates **physiological measures**—gut microbiome and blood biomarkers—to understand the interface between immune function and social cognition.

Mental Representations of Social Categories. I investigate how people mentally represent **social class and inequality**, how these representations vary with political ideology, and how they shape discriminatory judgments.

Methodologically, I integrate experimental approaches with computational modeling, meta-analysis, and physiological measurement. I am committed to **open science practices**, including preregistration and registered reports.
